

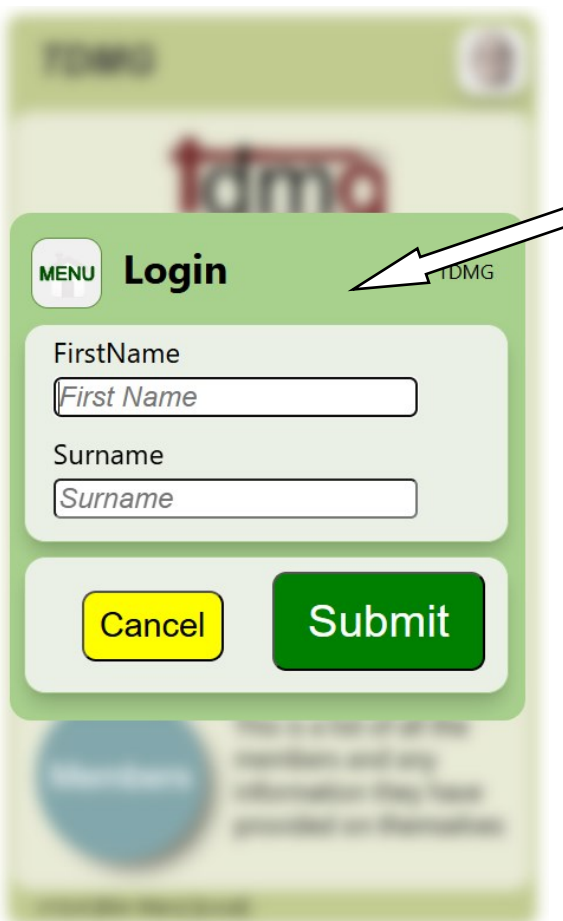
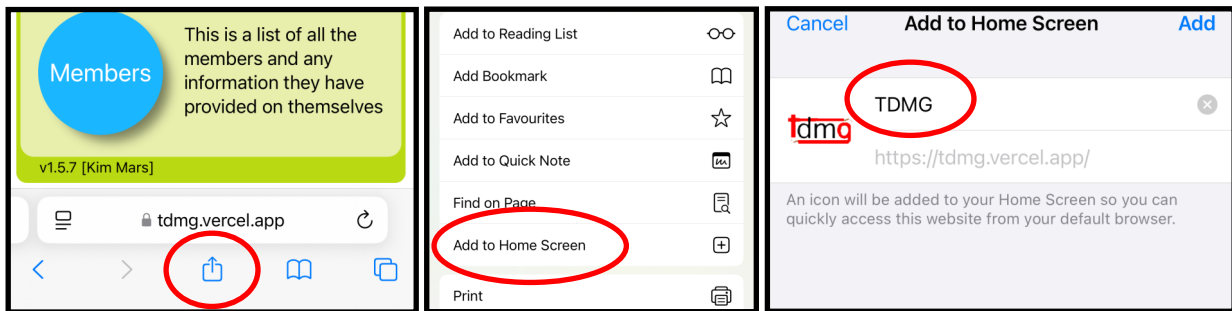
# TDMG App

V1.6.0

This App was developed to make it easier for an event organiser to get a consensus on what event option within Event TBD (To Be Decided) should be chosen (if any), and once it becomes an Event then it shows who is coming. It is not designed to replace the WhatsApp group as this is purely a “are you going or not” system.

The App is a web-based app, so any device that can go on to the internet will be able to display it - smart phones, laptops, PC;s etc. To install the App, on your browser write in **tdmg.vercel.app**, and then save it as a favourite.

For example on an iPhone, start Safari, type in **tdmg.vercel.app** and follow what to do next from below



When you first fire up the App the login screen will appear. You must write your first name and surname as it is in the WhatsApp group (which is where I got the list of names). If you only have your first name in the WhatsApp group then you cannot login as I require both names. I recommend you insert your surname there and tell me when you've done it.

As part of using the App I would also like a passport type photo of yourself (smiling!), so top of shoulders upwards, as this will be used as your avatar. If you take the photo against a constant light coloured background then I can remove the background so only your head is in the picture.

A small cookie is left on your device with just your Member ID (which you never see), so your device will remember your login details and you won't need to do it each time.

# Main Menu



Your avatar

This is the main menu. It has three buttons. The text next to each button tells you what they do.

The buttons start off as grey (disabled). This is because the system is loading the data for each of these buttons, and only when this data is ready will the buttons be usable.

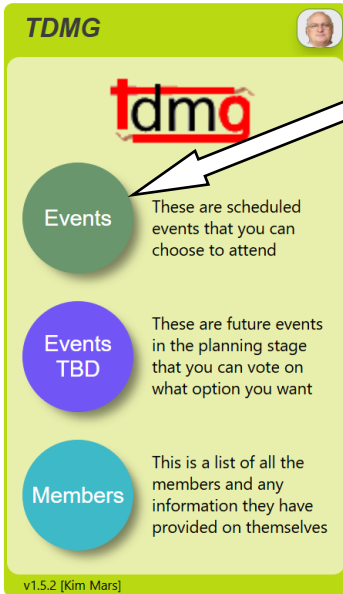

# Events

# Events List and Info Screens



When you press this button ...

...you go to the **Events list screen**. These are events that you can choose to attend.

Clicking on a particular **Event** in the list ...

Changes the sort order, between Date and Name

Goes back to the main menu

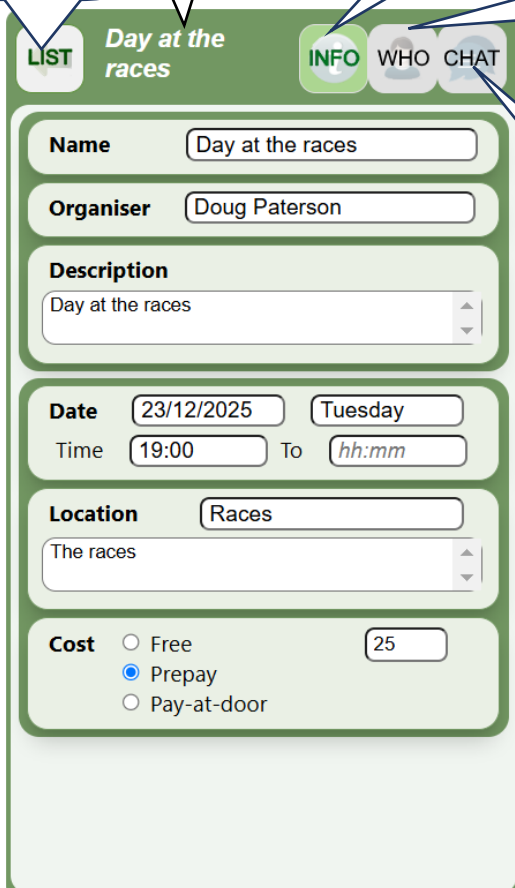


... takes you to the **Event Info** screen below.

This button takes you to the **Event Info** page showing the basic information about this event. This picture is of the **Info** page.

Goes back to the **Events List**

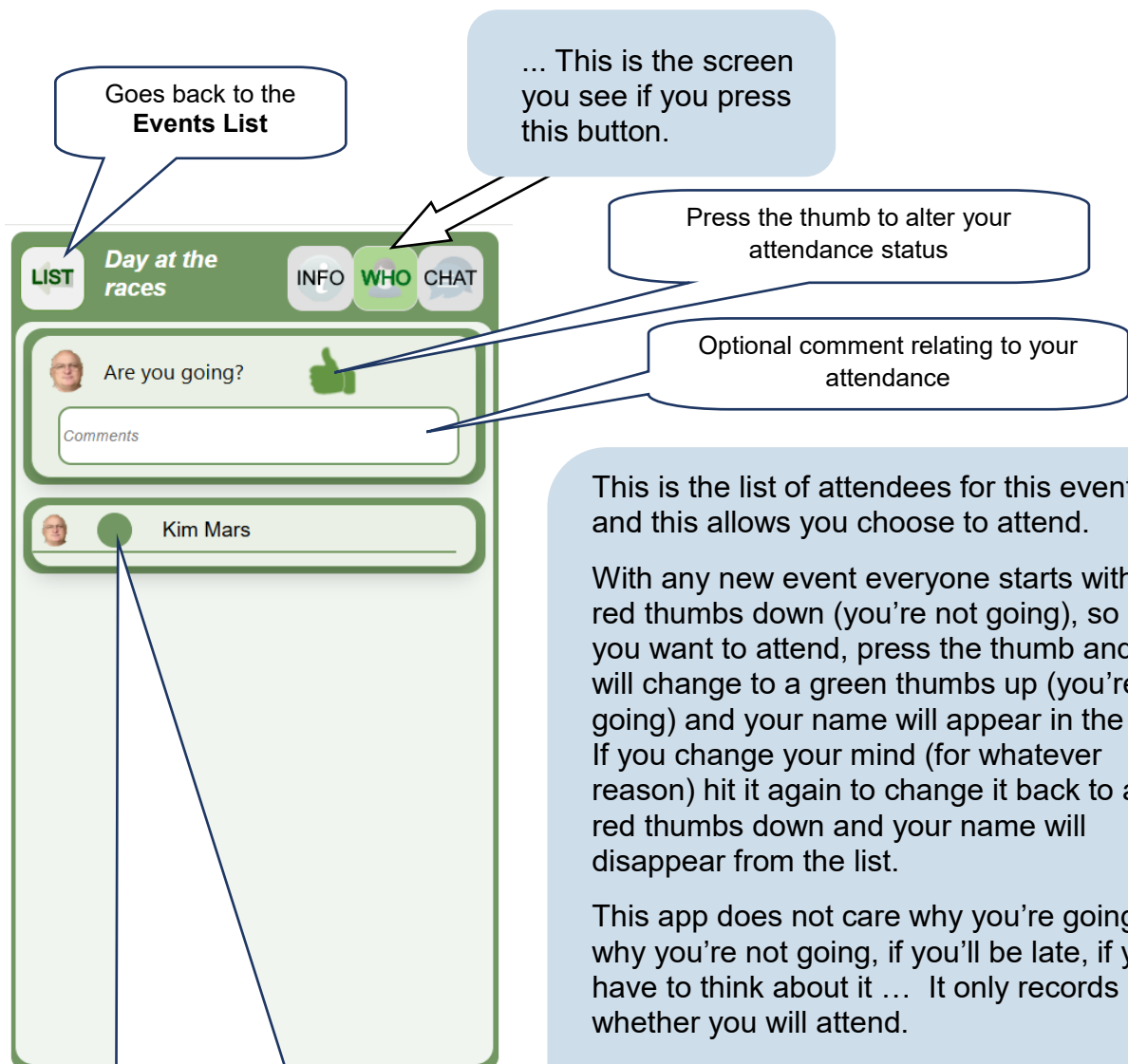
This takes you to the **Event People** page showing who is attending. It also allows you to say whether you are going. (see **Page 4**)



This takes you to the **Event Chat** page showing any chat about this event (see **Page 5**)

## Events ...cont

## Events People Screen



This is the list of attendees for this event, and this allows you choose to attend.

With any new event everyone starts with a red thumbs down (you're not going), so if you want to attend, press the thumb and it will change to a green thumbs up (you're going) and your name will appear in the list. If you change your mind (for whatever reason) hit it again to change it back to a red thumbs down and your name will disappear from the list.

This app does not care why you're going, why you're not going, if you'll be late, if you have to think about it ... It only records whether you will attend.

The comment below the thumb **ONLY** relates to your attendance, and it is something the organiser might need/want to know.

This colour circle relates to a 'pre-payment', if there is one. Green means paid in full, yellow means partially paid, red means not paid. The comment can be used in this instance.

For events that are 'free' or 'pay-at-door' this will always be green

The list **ONLY** shows members who are **GOING**

This is NOT a good example of what to chat about !!

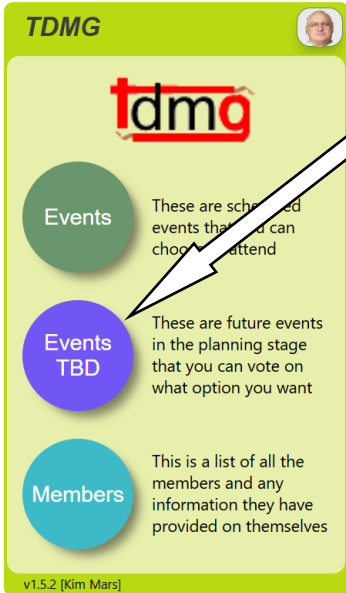
This button will clear anything you have written (and not sent). It is greyed out until you write something.

# Events TBD List and Info Screens



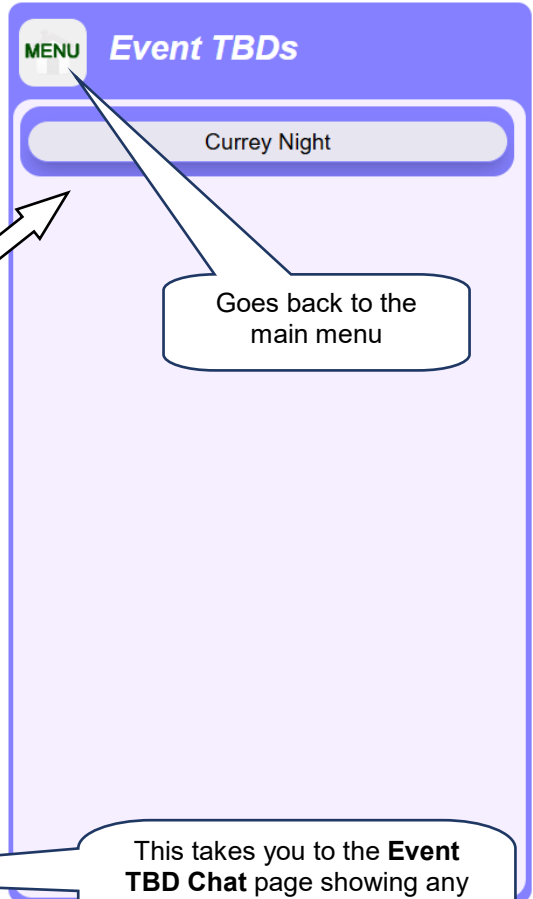
When you press this button ...

...you go to the **Event TBDS** list. These are events that are to be decided by you voting on up to 3 options for date and time.

Clicking on a particular **Event TBD** in the list ...

... takes you to the **Event TBDS Info** screen.

Goes back to the **Event TBDS List**



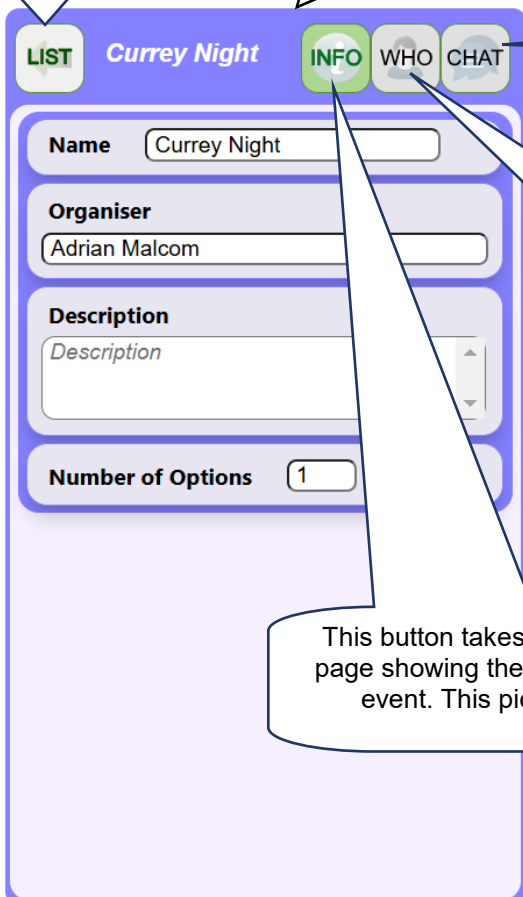
Goes back to the main menu

This takes you to the **Event TBD Chat** page showing any chat about this potential event (*see Page 8*)

This takes you to the **People** page where you can choose which option, if any, you want to go with (*see Page 7*).

Once again the default is not to go, thereby not choosing any option)

This button takes you to the **Event TBD Info** page showing the basic information about this event. This picture is of the **Info** page.

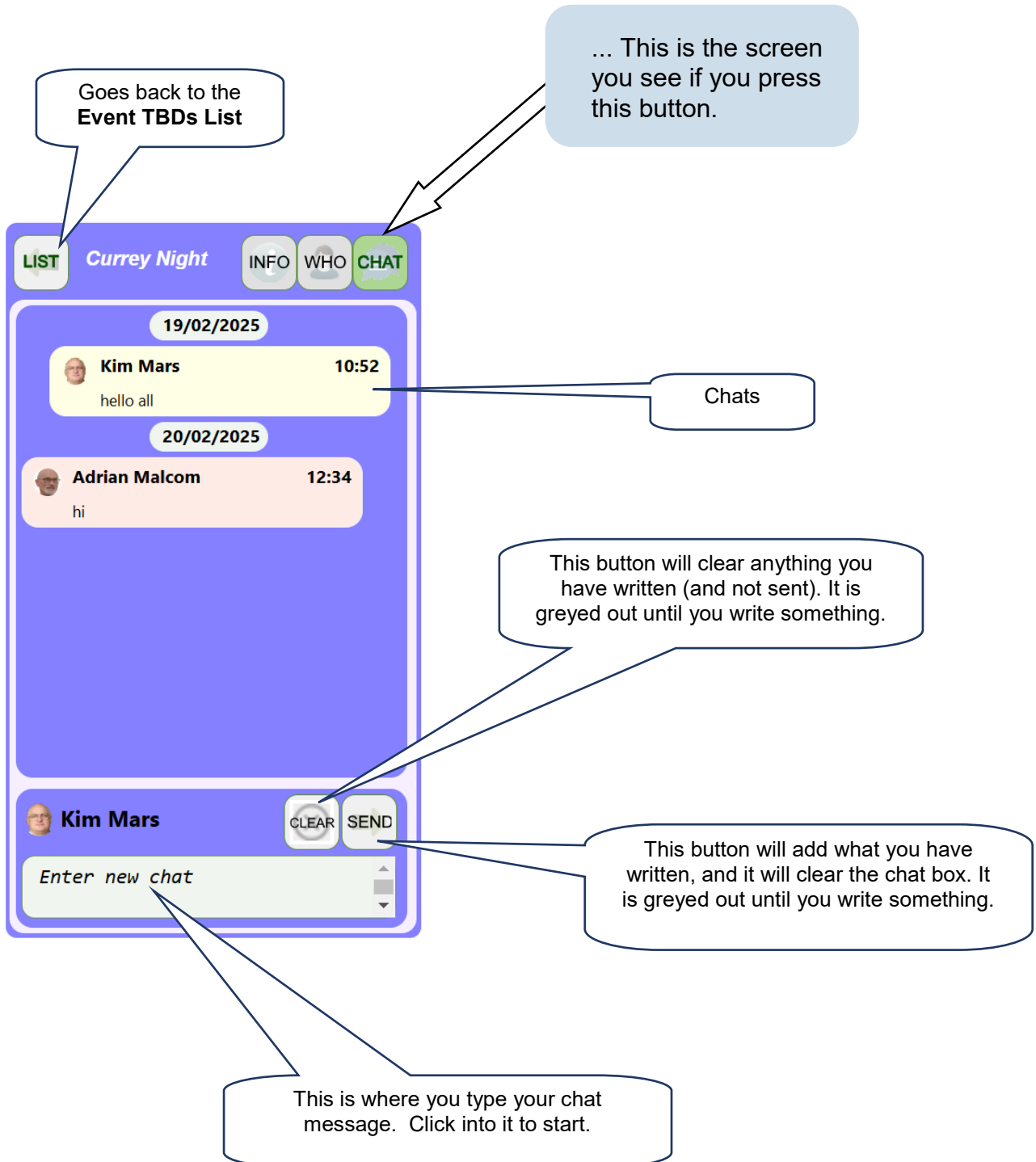

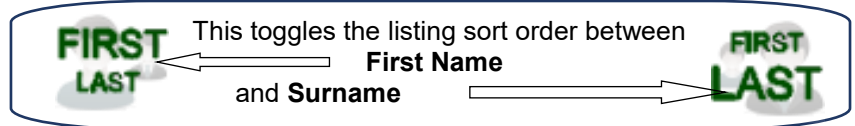

# Members List and Info Screens



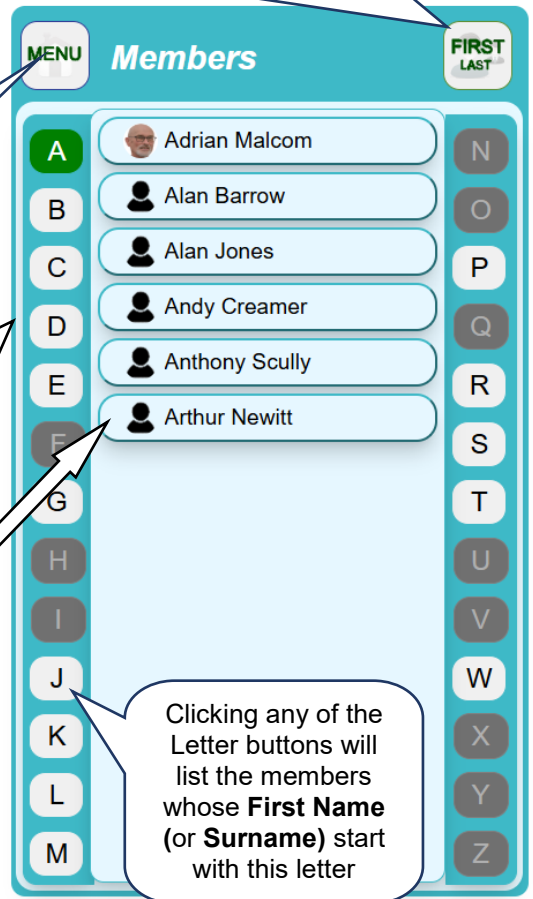
When you press this button ...

Goes back to the main menu

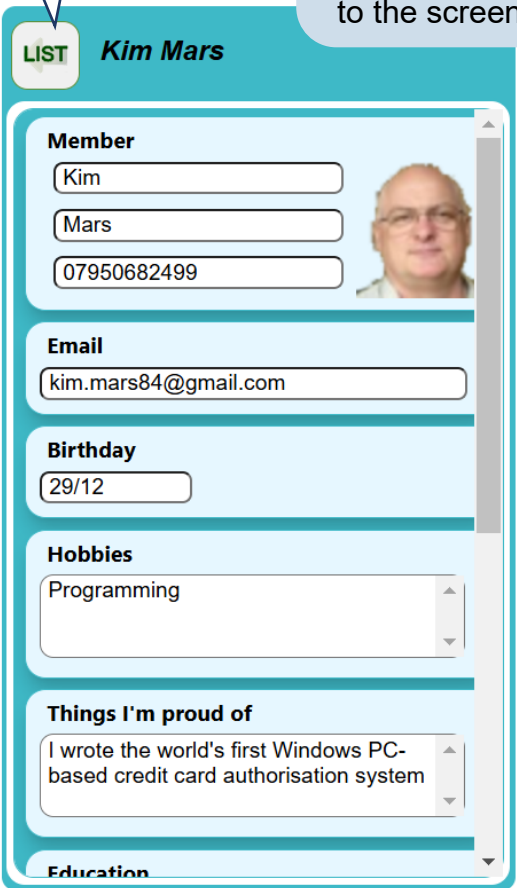
...you go to the **Members** list. This lists all the members of the TDMG

Goes back to the **Members List**

When you click on a **Member** in the list you go to the screen below left.



Clicking any of the Letter buttons will list the members whose **First Name** (or **Surname**) start with this letter



The **Member's** page shows any information that a member wants to share about themselves with the group.

Apart from the **First Name** and **Surname** every other piece of info is optional. You could say nothing about yourself, but then there's no value in that, the purpose of the TDMG is to provide a place to share and have a laugh.

Please do not lie about anything, say nothing instead.

Please give me a passport size photo of yourself (smiling) on a clear plain background. I want members to be able to put a name to the face, and a face to the name.

# Organisers and Super Users

The organisers of events get a few more buttons to use as they need to add or delete data along the way.

In the same way there are a few designated 'super-users' who also have extra buttons.

This allows a 'super-user' to add an **Event**

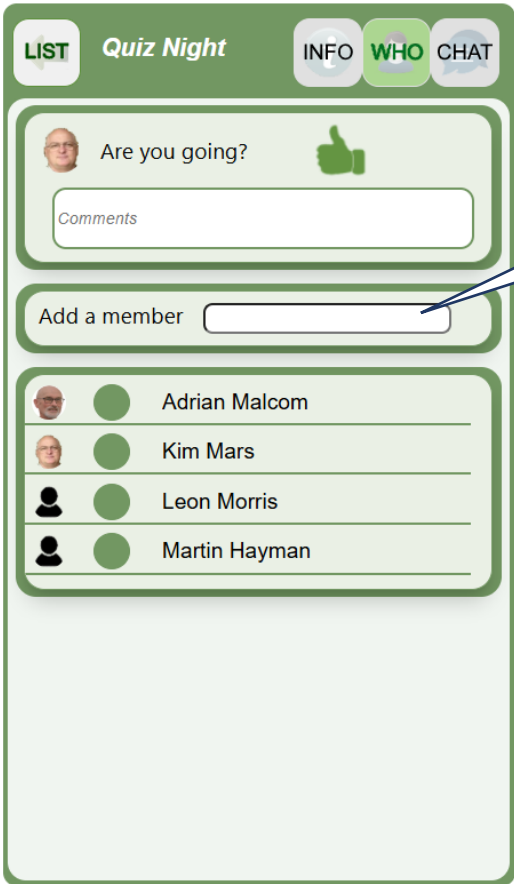

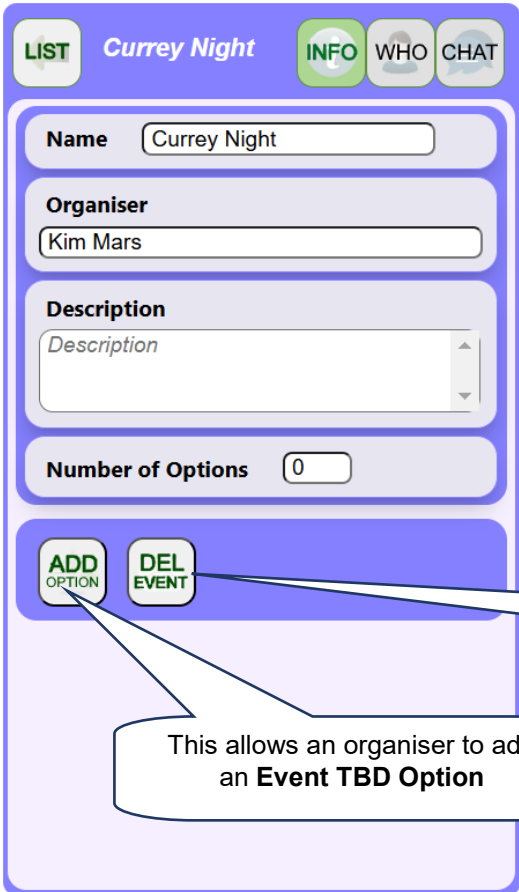
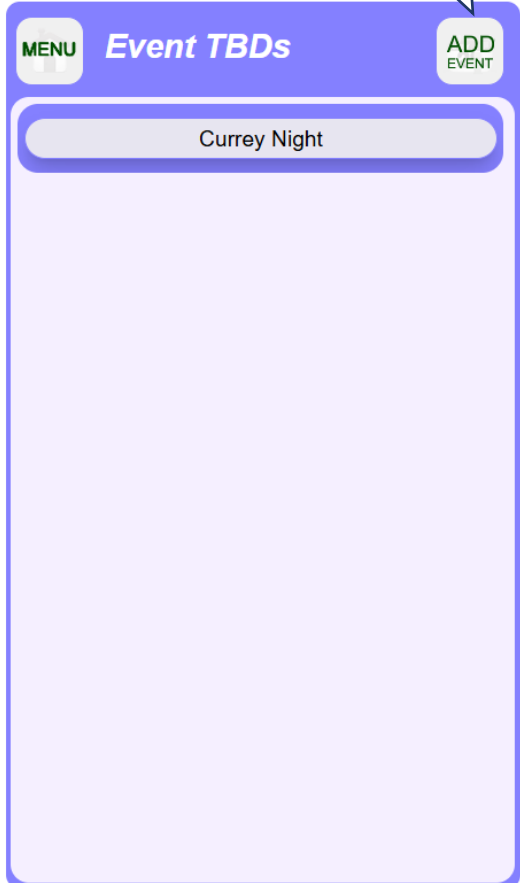
These provide stats about the event - **Unread** means the number of members who have not visited this page, **No** is the number of members who have seen the **Info Page** but have chosen not to attend, and **Yes** are those who have chosen to attend.

# Organisers and Super Users



An organiser can add a person who will attend but does not have a smart phone to add themselves to the list.

This allows a 'super-user' to add an **Event TBD**



This allows an organiser to delete an entire **Event TBD**.

# Organisers and Super Users

This allows an organiser to delete an **Event TBD Option** (although this is not recommended)

This allows an organiser to convert the 'winning' option into an **Event**. Enter the winning Option in the box to the right, then press this button.

It will also make all those members who have voted for this option, and those who voted 'Any', to be included as members of the new **Event**.

Lastly, it will delete the **Event TBD** and all its linked pages,

This allows an organiser to add a new **Event TBD Option**, up to maximum of 3
